Kroger's Fred Meyer division announced its business decision on March 16, 2018 to exit the firearms and ammunition category. Those products were sold only at Fred Meyer stores in Alaska, Idaho, Oregon and Washington, and represented \$7 million in annual revenue – about 0.006% of Kroger's annual sales. Fred Meyer is quickly working to responsibly phase out sales of firearms and ammunition.
