

## Foreign Supplier Verification Program (FSVP)



When **Kroger is the FSVP Importer**, all facilities that perform the [latest value-add](#) step for products sold to Kroger must be disclosed in Supplier Hub.

### FSVP Supplier Requirements

Document	Facilities outside Australia, Canada, or New Zealand	Facilities in Australia, Canada, or New Zealand
GFSI-recognized Food Safety Certificate	<b>Required</b>	<b>Required</b>
Full GFSI Audit Report, including any non-conformances and corrective actions taken, if applicable	<b>Required</b>	May be requested
Full Food Safety Plan, including the hazard analysis for each product provided	<b>Required</b>	May be requested
Name and certification of the Qualified Individual who reviewed the Food Safety Plan; the person named on the QI certificate must be the same person who signs the Food Safety Plan.	<b>Required</b>	May be requested
Proof of compliance with Country Food Safety Standards (e.g., Safe Food for Canadians license)	N/A	<b>Required</b>
Copy of product labels	May be requested	May be requested
Additional Food Safety documents as needed	May be requested	May be requested

### Notes

- All required and requested documents **must be in English** and uploaded to Supplier Hub.
- All documents **must be current** at the time of review.
- Documents **without an expiration date** must be reviewed by a qualified individual at least once per year, EVEN IF NO CHANGES ARE MADE. The review must be documented. Example: Food Safety Plans.

### Once plan is approved

- Kroger will issue the **FSVP Statement of Consent** to the vendor/supplier, which includes instructions on what must be disclosed on customs documents.
- The vendor/supplier **must not list Kroger as the FSVP Importer** on any customs documents until the consent has been provided.
